is a pre-mixed, high performance, drywall joint compound. It can be used for filling and finishing drywall joints, fasteners and trims. It has excellent workability and working time, very low shrinkage, excellent slip and superior sandability. It goes on very easily and provides a very smooth finished surface with virtually no surface imperfections.

Light Weight Topping meets or exceeds ASTM C-475 "Standard specification for Joint Compound and Joint Tape for Finishing Gypsum Board".

Maintain a minimum air, surface and compound temperature of $10^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\left(50^{\circ} \mathrm{F}\right)$ for 48 hours prior to application and until "dry" and stable.

All surfaces must be firm, clean, dry and free of foreign substances. Open spaces between panels or voids of $3 \mathrm{~mm}\left(1 / 8^{\prime \prime}\right)$ or more should be pre-filled with compound at least 24 hours prior to first coat work. Hamilton Drywall Products Ultra-Fill or Smooth Set Lites are recommended for larger fills.

In a clean container mix mechanically to a smooth, creamy consistency, adding more water as required. Add water in 125 ml ( $1 / 2$ cup) increments to avoid over thinning.

For interior use only. This product is not recommended for embedding drywall tape. Apply with hand or mechanical tools. Allow compound to dry thoroughly between coats. ing on application type. application type. 6 months.

When sanding, use 180 -grit or finer sandpaper or 220 -grit mesh cloth. Avoid scuffing gypsum panel paper.
